A22/01/82 Resident of Newbury Close concerns over Community Woodland Lower hedge. Works identified as needing completing on the lower hedge of the community woodland cannot be completed by the Axe Vale Conservation Society who maintain the woodland due to insurance levels. The clerk has contacted Jason Mair to arrange a site visit for him to have a look and submit a quote.
